# ***IICRC Approved Schools***

The IICRC owns no schools and produces no training materials. However, the IICRC does recognize established schools throughout the nation that meet specific standards of certification. Anyone attending these schools has the option at the end of the course to take the IICRC Certification Examination. That examination, along with proper application and fees, is forwarded to the IICRC for processing. Once a person meets the qualifications, they are sent Certification credentials.

**Certification:** Certification testing begins immediately following the course.

**Note:** Separate application and cheque or credit card, payable to the IICRC in U.S. Funds, is required for certification. This must be paid to the instructor at exam time. Certification fee is \$65.00 U.S.
